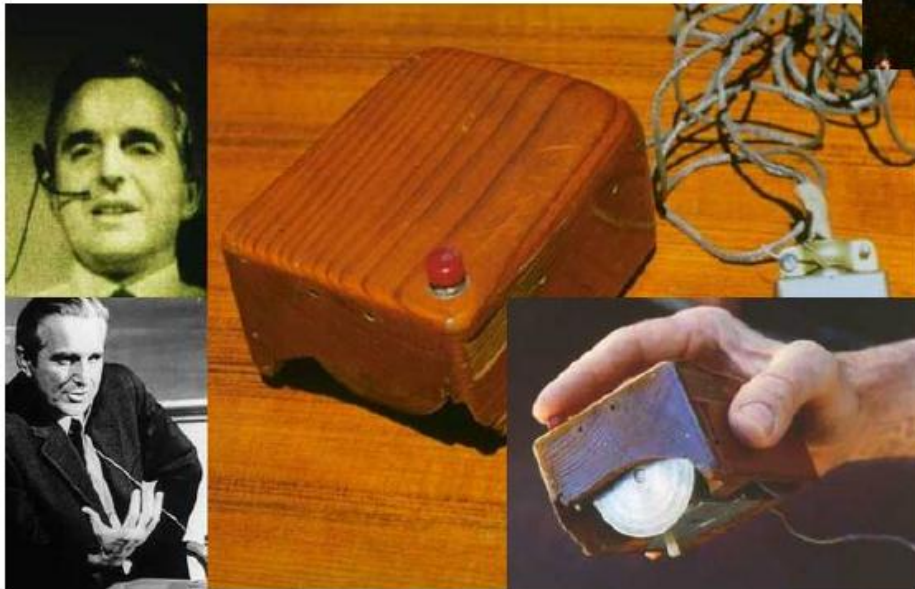
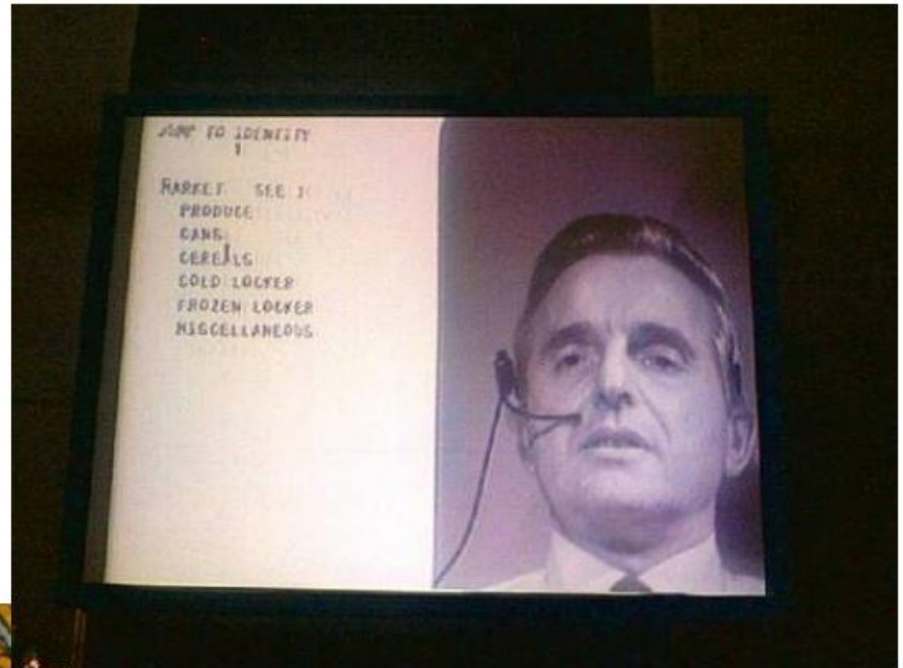
- The mission I was given:

The Breckinridge and Lane Democrats, having taken courage at the recent eastern advices, are organizing energetically for the campaign. 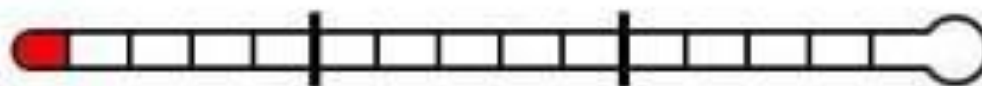

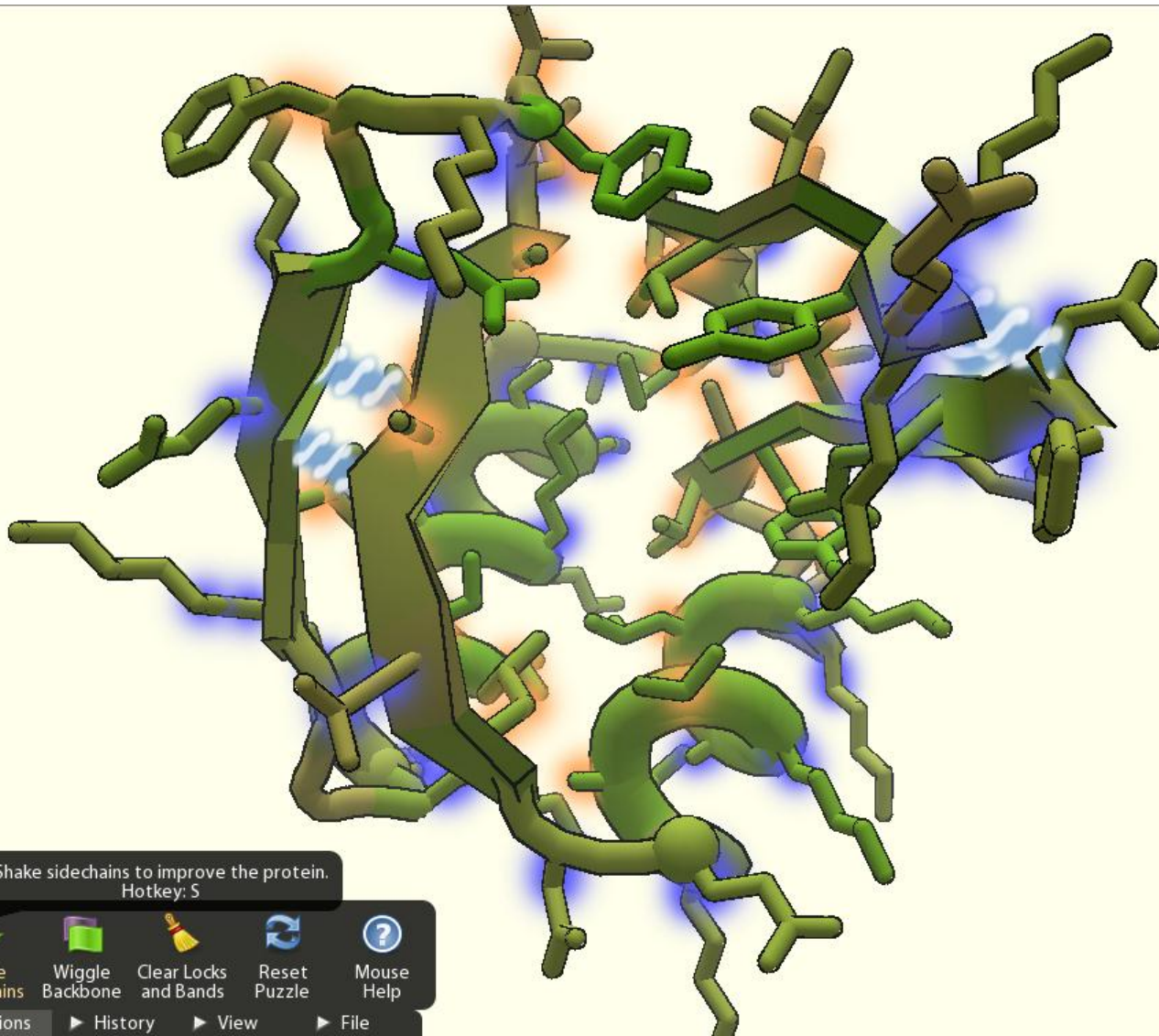

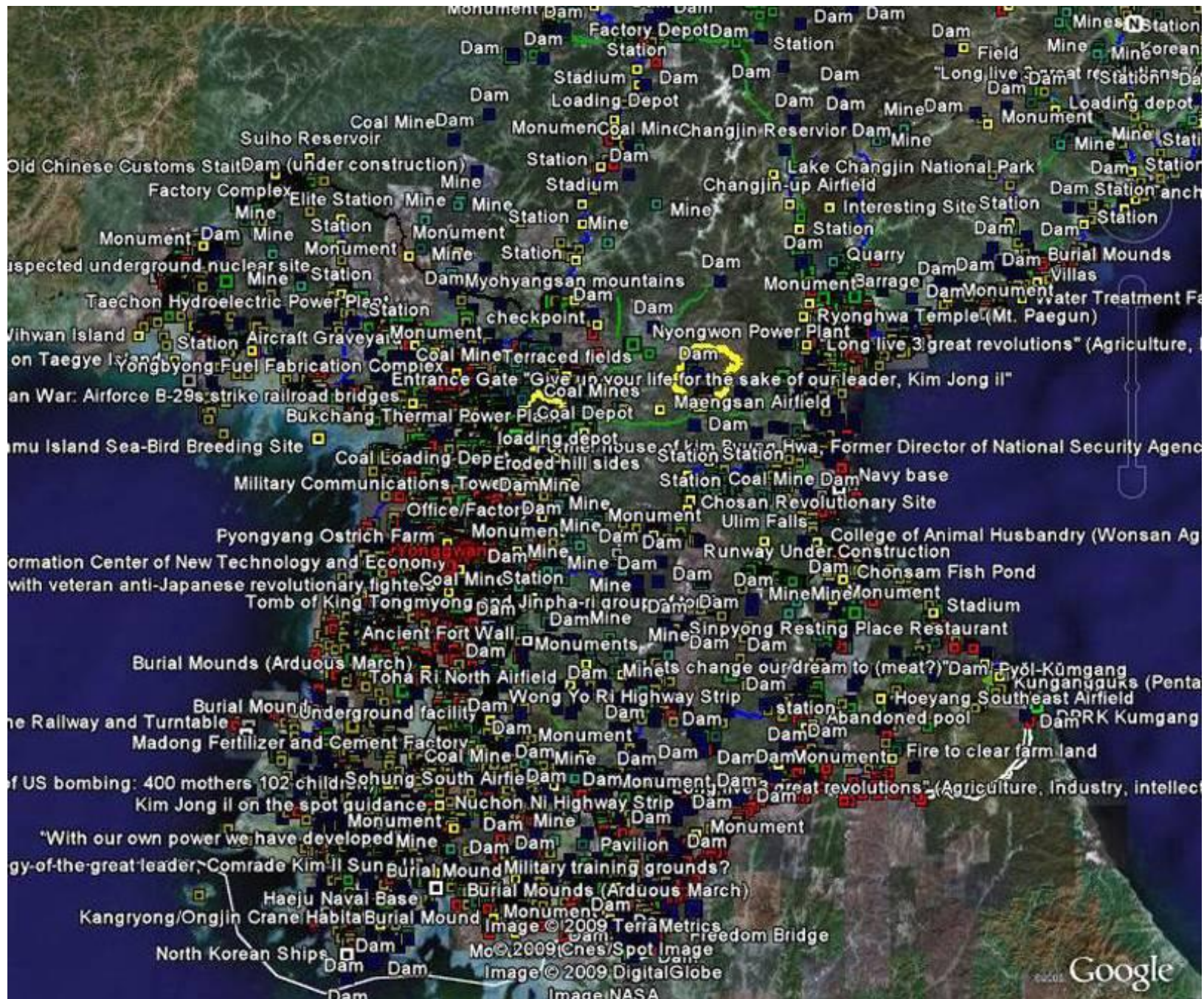

# DARPA Network Challenge Results

- A total cost of \$79,000
- Almost 4,400 teams from around the world
  - Teams from Sudan, Iran, Russia, India, Brazil, ...
- The winning MIT team found the balloons in less than 9 hours
  - Stiff competition from GaTech, NerdFighters, many others
- 9 novel approaches used by the top 50 teams
- Results briefed throughout DoD leadership

  - Plus External Research, Extreme Computing Group, ...

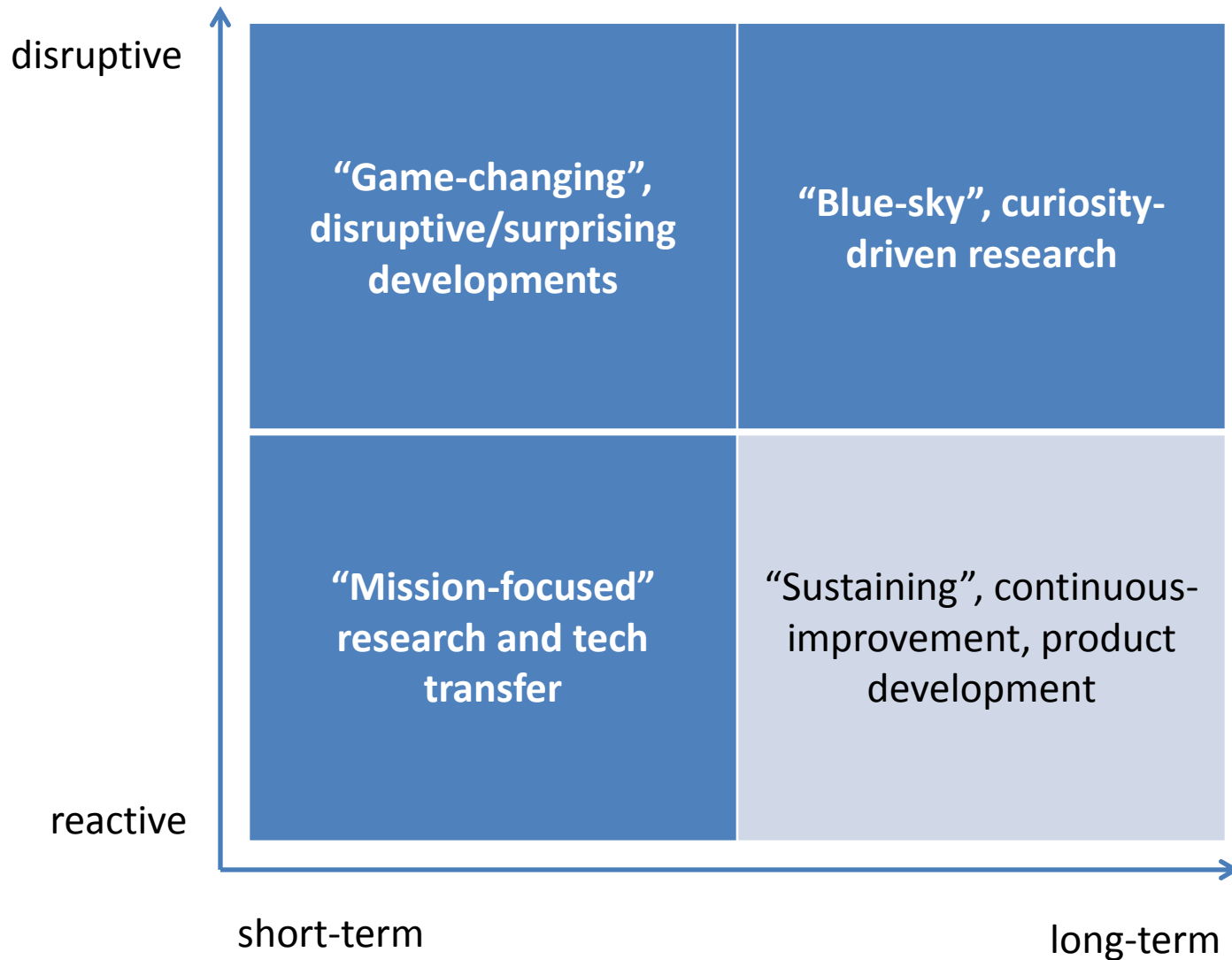


# MSR Mission

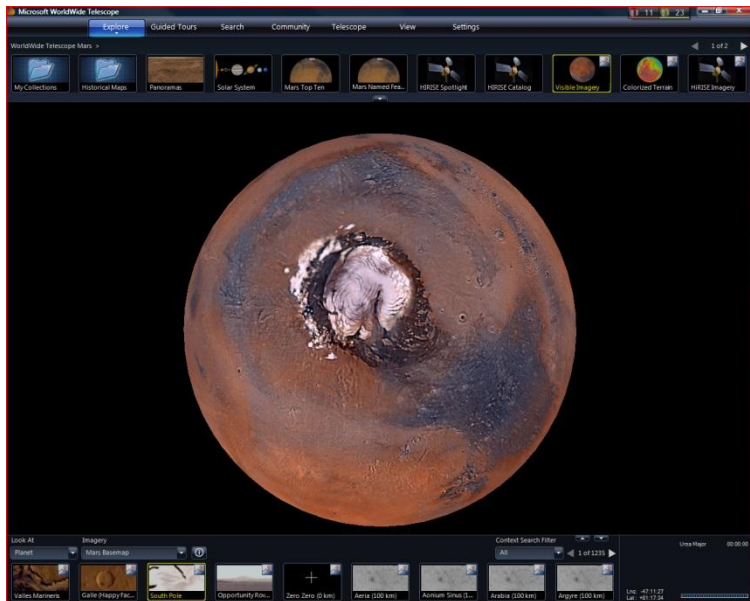
- Advance the state of the art in the areas we choose to do research.
- When we have great ideas, work hard to get them into our products.

- Roughly, the strategy: Get the best people, make sure they are fully resourced, and then get out of the way

# MSR Redmond

- The “mother ship” lab, founded in 1991
- About 350 researchers and engineers
  - engaged mainly in open research
  - opportunistic tech transfer
  - organized into 8 broad research divisions
  - plus an engineering division
- About 400 PhD student interns each summer
- Broad array of external programs and outreach
