

...led to the creation of (D)ARPA in 1958





- The winning MIT team found the balloons in less than 9 hours
 - Stiff competition from GaTech, NerdFighters, many others
- 9 novel approaches used by the top 50 teams
- Results briefed throughout DoD leadership

MSR Redmond


- The "mother ship" lab, founded in 1991
